- assume normal adjunct faculty duties, as assigned.

Qualifications:

- graduate degree preferred in ASL/Sign Language Studies, Linguistics, Second Language Acquisition/Teaching or related field. Candidates without a graduate degree will be considered based on prior teaching experience;
- prior teaching experience in higher education preferred;
- native users of ASL and members of the Deaf community preferred;
- knowledge of current trends in American Sign Language research and instruction;
- comfort utilizing instructional technology such as Blackboard and GoReact;
- ASLTA (American Sign Language Teaching Association) certification desirable.
