Responsibilities:

- teach *Fundamentals of Acting* TRE 1010, scheduled T/Th 2:30-4:00pm, Fall 2018 semester
Course description: *An exploration of the basics of acting through exercises that build a process from script page to stage, including approaching a script, preparation and research, and how to work collaboratively in the professional world. Scripts used include monologues and scene work. Preparation and research of scripts include investigating not only the particulars of the script itself, but how it relates historically to the periods in which it is set, in which it was written, and to the history of theater. Open to all students.*

- graduate degree in drama or related field, or tested experience in related field
- prior teaching of drama experience in secondary or collegiate institutions preferred
- demonstrated ability in performance and/or directing on stage or film
- comfort utilizing instructional technology such as Blackboard
