RECOGNIZING, the Student Senate advocates for a basketball court to be installed beside the newly installed sand volleyball courts.


WHEREAS, the basketball court should be installed as soon as possible to immediately benefit student engagement on campus.


RECOGNIZING, that the relocation of the hoops is the first step but an upgrade is the ultimate goal.

A RESOLUTION TO:

Advocate for the relocation of the basketball hoops.

RATIONALE:

In light of the construction of the new residence halls beginning in the coming month, the Student Senate advocates for the relocation of the basketball hoops. The new residence halls will be built right on top of the space that is currently allocated for this recreational activity. Seeing that there are multiple students and faculty members that use the basketball hoops daily, it is essential that we relocate them for future.
