



2017–2018 Verification of SNAP Benefits Dependent Student

Your 2017–2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law requires that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, we will compare your FAFSA with the information on this form and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You must complete and sign this form, attach any required documents and submit to the Financial Aid Office within 30 days of this request. We may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact the Financial Aid Office as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed. Your financial aid eligibility cannot be determined, and financial aid will not be awarded or disbursed, until the verification process is complete.

B. Verification of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Benefits
