



Spring/Summer 2017 Parent PLUS Loan Form

This form must be completed by the parent accepting the Federal Direct PLUS Loan for Parents. Direct PLUS Loans are for the parents of dependent students. This is a credit-based program and requires a credit check to establish eligibility. Interest is charged during all periods, even during the time a student is in school. The repayment period for a Direct PLUS Loan begins 60 days after you have received the last disbursement of the loan for that academic year, unless you request a deferment.

The student must carry a minimum of 6 undergraduate semester hours in the spring/summer term to qualify for a PLUS loan. The student must be registered before the loan will be processed.
