- Complete items 1a – 4, if you are not married ignore the spouse lines
- Check Line 7 Verification of Non-filing
- Line 9 – enter 12/31/2023 for Year or period requested
- Check the box above the Sign Here that starts with, “Signatory attests that..”
- Sign and date the form
