WHAT <u>NOT</u> TO BRING

- No candles, incense, fireworks, weapons
- No halogen lamps
- No multi-bulb light fixtures or "octopus" lamps
- No pets, except fish
- No two prong extension cords only three prong extension cords are permitted
- No hotplates or any electrical appliance with open or exposed heating element
- No wireless routers or any device that may interfere with our network
- No toaster or toaster ovens
- No masking or cellophane tape, nails
- You may not bring your own air-conditioner
- No waterbeds
- No self-built lofts or bunking. The beds provided can be lofted in most rooms but do require a rented loft kit through College Products
- Personal microwave are not allowed
- No string lights
- No Air fryer
- Sink
 - Each room in the UC has a sink
- Kitchen Space
 - Full kitchens are located in each residence hall for residential use




