- The Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) will satisfy all Madonna University Core Courses. MTA does not satisfy Madonna University Signature Courses.
- Madonna University will transfer a Maximum of 74 credits from community colleges towards the minimum total of 120 semester hours needed for a first Bachelor degree unless stated otherwise in the articulated agreement. Courses must be approved for transfer, non-remedial and have a grade above a 2.0 (“C”) or higher. Students pursuing a course of study under an existing articulation agreement should contact Madonna University’s Articulation Specialist, Chelsea Driscoll - cdriscoll@madonna.edu in the Office of the Registrar to discuss approved and maximum credit allowance.
- Students who are pursuing or who have earned the MACRAO Transfer Agreement should contact Madonna University as the requirements in the Core Curriculum will vary.
