- The Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) will satisfy all Madonna University Core Courses. MTA does not satisfy Madonna University Signature Courses. Students without MTA must meet the Madonna University requirements for Core Curriculum (core and signature courses) and Major. Students without the associate degree named must meet the Madonna University requirements for the major. Please see the Madonna University online catalog for more details outlining these plans.
- Madonna University will transfer a maximum of 74 credits from community colleges towards the minimum total of 120 semester hours needed for a first Bachelor degree unless otherwise specified in the articulated agreement. Courses must be approved for transfer, non-remedial, and have a grade of C (2.0) or higher. Students pursuing a course of study under an existing articulation agreement should contact Madonna University’s Articulation Specialist ([articulation@madonna.edu](mailto:articulation@madonna.edu)) in the Office of the Registrar to discuss approved and maximum credit allowance.
- Transfer credits will be awarded according to the number of credits earned at the home institution, not the hours of the equivalent course at Madonna University.
