Transfer Options for Satisfying Core Curriculum Requirements

Students may satisfy Madonna University's Core Curriculum requirements in two ways. For guidance on the best option for your situation, please consult with both your Lourdes University and Madonna University (MU) advisor, and refer to the resources noted below. Madonna University will apply a maximum of 74 credits from community colleges unless otherwise stipulated in another agreement.

OPTION #1: Completing MU's Core Curriculum through MTA or MACRAO

In many cases, completing the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) is beneficial for fulfilling MU's Core Curriculum requirements. When transferring with MTA or MACRAO, students must also satisfy the Signature Courses listed below. *(MACRAO students refer to the current undergraduate catalog linked below for full information and requirements.)*

OPTION #2: Completing MU's Core Curriculum by Individual Goal

For this option, each of the Core Curriculum goals must be fulfilled by completing at least one course of 3 or more credits as outlined in the table below.

MU Core Course Requirements	Lourdes University Transfer Options
CC-1A Written and Spoken Communication: Written Communication	Choose two: ENG 101 (3 s.h.), ENG 102 (3 s.h.)
CC-1B Written and Spoken Communication: Personal and Public Communication	Choose one: COM 102 (3 s.h.)
CC-2 Intercultural Knowledge	Choose one: MUS 201 (3 s.h.)
CC-3 Civic and Global Identity	Equivalent Coursework not available at Lourdes University
CC-4 Social Sciences	Choose two (from different subjects): CSJ 101 (3 s.h.), CSJ 202 (3 s.h.)
CC-5 Mathematics	Choose one: MTH 224 (3 s.h.), or MTH 225 (3 s.h.)
CC-6A Scientific Inquiry: Biological Sciences (at least one of the courses in either the Biological or Physical Sciences must include a laboratory science experience)	Choose one: BIO 201 (3 s.h.), BIO 202 (3 s.h.), BIO 204 (3 s.h.), or BIO 240 (3 s.h.)
CC-6B Scientific Inquiry: Physical Sciences (at least one of the courses in either the Biological or Physical Sciences must include a laboratory science experience)	Choose one: CHM 130 (3 s.h.), CHM 181 (3 s.h.), CHM 301 (3 s.h.), PHS/PLA 201 (5 s.h.), OR PHS/PLA 301 (5 s.h.)
Signature Course Requirements	
SC-7 Literature and Informational Fluency	ENG 302 (3 s.h.), ENG 303 (3 s.h.)
SC-8A Religious Values: The Madonna Heritage*	*Must be taken at Madonna University
SC-8B Religious Values: Religious Studies	Choose one: THS 2105 (3 s.h.), THS 220 (3 s.h.), THS 221 (3 s.h.), THS 244 (3 s.h.), THS 246 (3 s.h.), or THS 340 (3 s.h.)
SC-9 Diverse Perspectives	Choose one: CSJ 304 (3 s.h.), or ENG 213 (3 s.h.)
