Transfer Options for Satisfying Core Curriculum Requirements

Students may satisfy Madonna University's Core Curriculum requirements in two ways. For guidance on the best option for your situation, please consult both your Macomb Community College and Madonna University (MU) advisors, and refer to the resources noted below. Madonna University will apply a maximum of 74 credits from community colleges unless otherwise stipulated in another agreement.

OPTION #1: Completing MU's Core Curriculum through MTA or MACRAO

In many cases, completing the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) is beneficial for fulfilling MU's Core Curriculum requirements. When transferring with MTA or MACRAO, students must also satisfy the Signature Courses listed below. *(MACRAO students refer to the current undergraduate catalog linked below for full information and requirements.)*

OPTION #2: Completing MU's Core Curriculum by Individual Goal

For this option, each of the Core Curriculum goals must be fulfilled by completing at least one course of 3 or more credits as outlined in the table below.

MU Core Course Requirements	Macomb Community College Options
CC-1A Written and Spoken Communication: Written Communication	Choose two: ENGL 1181 or ENGL 1210 and ENGL 1190 or ENGL 1220
CC-1B Written and Spoken Communication: Personal and Public Communication	Choose one: SPCH 1060 or SPCH 2100
CC-2 Intercultural Knowledge	Choose one: ENGL 2800, ENGL 2810 or MUSC 1030
CC-3 Civic and Global Identity	Choose one: PHIL 2010 or POLS 1000
CC-4 Social Sciences	Choose two (from different subjects): PSYC 1010, PSYC 2600, SOCY 1010 or SOCY 1100
CC-5 Mathematics	Choose one: MATH 1100, MATH 1280, MATH 1290, MATH 1340, MATH 1360, MATH 1370, MATH 1415, MATH 1435, MATH 1465, MATH 1760, MATH 1770, MATH 2000, MATH 2200, MATH 2760, MATH 2770, or PSYC 2170
CC-6A Scientific Inquiry: Biological Sciences (At least one of the courses in either the Biological or Physical Sciences must include a laboratory science experience.)	Choose one: BIOL 1700, BIOL 1800, BIOL 1310, BIOL 1400, BIOL 2400, or BIOL 2710
CC-6B Scientific Inquiry: Physical Sciences (At least one of the courses in either the Biological or Physical Sciences must include a laboratory science experience.)	Choose one: ASTR 1030 and ASTR 1040 (must have both to satisfy CC-6B with lab), CHEM 1000, CHEM 1050, CHEM 1060, CHEM 1170, CHEM 1180, CHEM 2260, CHEM 2270, ESCI 1210 or PHSA 1050
Signature Course Requirements	
SC-7 Literature and Informational Fluency	Choose one: ENGL 1730, ENGL 2510, ENGL 2520, or ENGL 2730
SC-8A Religious Values: The Madonna Heritage*	*Must be taken at Madonna University
SC-8B Religious Values: Religious Studies	Choose one: HUMN 1700, HUMN 2000 or HUMN 2100
SC-9 Diverse Perspectives	SOCY 2550
