

## A Laudato Si' Perspective




We must recognize our interconnectedness to creation...we must respond to non-human creation as "brother" and "sister"

By paying attention to the details in creation and looking for opportunities to gaze contemplatively at nature, we can develop an awareness of the intrinsic value of everything that exists



Contact with nature needs to be a fundamental component of our way of life...A trip to the ocean, a walk in the woods, working in the garden, etc. are important, not primarily for what they produce, but for their inherent Christ-contact.

Flashes down too fast to follow, quick and quicker carves its hollow


In the water, slings its arrow superswift to swallow


Stickleback or shrimp or minnow.

Evening angler, weather-teller, rainbringer and


Rainbow bird - that sets the stream alight with burn and glitter!





# Parish or School Gardens-Mary & Pollinator





- Spotted Joe Pye Weed (Eupatoriadelphus maculatus)
   I plant, 3-foot spacing
- Smooth Blue Aster (Symphyotrichum laeve) 3 plants, 2-foot spacing
- 3 Ironweed (Vernonia fasciculata)
  3 plants, 2-foot spacing
- Wild Bergamot (Monarda fistulosa)
  3 plants, 2-foot spacing
- Purple Coneflower (Echinacea purpurea)
  3 plants, 1-foot spacing
- 6 Butterfly Milkweed (Asclepias tuberosa)
  3 plants, 2-foot spacing



Low Border Plants

Forget-me-not - Eyes of Mary
Impatiens - Mother Love
Petunia - Our Lady's Praises
Sweet Alyssum - Flower of the Cross

Suggested add-ons": Showy Goldenrod (Solidago speciosa), Sideoats Grama (Bouteloua curtipendula), Purple Love Grass (Engrostis spectabilis), and Rough Blazing Star (Liatris aspera).
