Madonna University Commencement Student Speaker Selection Process

Each year, Madonna University Commencement includes a Student Speaker to represent the graduating class. The Dean of each College or School nominates up to 3 students for consideration. Members of the graduating class may also apply for consideration. As representatives of the entire student body, Student Senate selects one Commencement Student Speaker annually.

Process

- 1. Deans from each College/School are invited to submit up to 3 student nominations per academic year by emailing student.senate@madonna.edu
 - College of Arts & Sciences
 - School of Business
 - College of Education & Human Development
 - College of Nursing & Health
- 2. Students nominated by their respective College/School Dean receive a communication to encourage them to submit their application.
- 3. Members of the current graduating class are also be encouraged to apply for Commencement Student Speaker
 - a. The selection process will be posted via QR code link at Student Affairs Office, Student Life Office, digital media, etc.
- 4. Student Speaker applications should include a resume and written speech.
 - a. Applications are due on March 7th each year
 - b. Email to student.senate@madonna.edu
- 5. Interviews (in-person or zoom) are conducted by the Student Senate Review Committee.
- 6. The Commencement student speech must be delivered in-person at Commencement.
- 7. The Commencement Student Speaker is announced by April 1st.

Timeline	
February 21-25	Announce Student Speaker Selection Process
February 28	Deans submit all nominations to Student Senate
March 1-4	All nominees are contacted and encouraged to apply
March 7	All applications are due
March 14-21	Selection Committee reviews applications
March 23-30	Conduct interviews
April 1	Announce final decision
