

If you were exposed to COVID-19

You were exposed to someone with COVID-19

Do you have symptoms?

Get tested, isolate, and follow the "if you have COVID-19 Symptoms decision tree".

Have you been fully vaccinated for COVID-19?
Fully Vaccinated defined as:
Either you have been boosted, or in the last six months you have completed the primary vaccination series of Moderna, Pfizer, J&J, or Novavax.

You may remain on campus. Wear a mask around others for 10 days. If possible test on day 5

Do Not come to campus. If on campus, leave immediately.

Isolate for 5 days
The date of your exposure is day 0. Day 1 is the first full day after your exposure to the individual with COVID-19

Complete and submit the Employee Covid-19 Disease Reporting Form and notify supervisor

Employee or Student?

Complete and submit the Student COVID-19 Disease Reporting Form and notify instructor/advisor

Isolate at home.

Commuter or Residential Student?

Isolate in the residence hall or at home.

Return to Campus*:
5 days after exposure OR
with a medical note clearing you to return due to a medical diagnosis unrelated to COVID-19
*Wear a mask for 5 days after returning to campus
